





DID YOU KNOW

Carpet weaving was a form of art, produced by everyone in Islamic societies. Artisans would work with fine materials like silk, metal-wrapped thread and the carpets would be enormous and very luxurious. They would feature in the royal court at reception halls, audience chambers, mosques and temples. King Akbar allowed Catholics to construct their churches in Agra and Lahore, and carpets decorated their walls too.





